Curriculum:

Project Washkon endeavors to meet program goals through a curriculum designed to enable students to:

- Develop proper study habits
- Experience achievement in homework assignments
- Expand reasoning and problem solving abilities
- Develop a better self-image and sense of identity
- Elaborate on regular school day activities
- Develop cultural self-esteem
- Become interested in a lifetime of learning
- Improve math, science, reading and writing through enrichment courses

During our Discovery Camp we will be working STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematic) activities.

Discipline Procedures:

Students will be under the supervision of certified school personnel familiar with school discipline policies and procedures. **Guidelines and rules are the same during Project Washkon as the regular school day.** Disrespect to staff or disregard of school rules will result in disciplinary action, which follows stated policies and procedures at the school, including possible removal from Project. Series of repeated misbehavior will result in contacting parents and failure to cooperate regarding disciplinary problems will result in dismissal from the after school activities. Students will be given three written or verbal warnings for minor offenses before removing them from the program.

Use or possession of alcohol or drugs is strictly forbidden. Use or possession of dangerous weapons is also strictly forbidden. Any violation of this drug and weapon policy will result in immediate dismissal from the program and the student will be referred to the school superintendent and appropriate law enforcement for further action.

Teacher/Student Concerns:

Any situation involving Project Washkoⁿ staff which causes a parent or guardian to be concerned should be discussed immediately following the incident. Project Washkoⁿ procedure is to contact the Director, Jacob Schuller and request an appointment for a conference. Proper school administration may also be contacted to attend a conference if necessary.

Transportation:

Project Washkoⁿ does not provide transportation to students that live in town. However, we do provide transportation to students that live in the country and in Macy. We have five drop off points in Macy. They are Macy Police Station, C-Store, Omaha Lodges, West Project and Housing Authority.
